L101A – 2010 Texas Prairie Dog Hunt – Chris Gill Family Circle Ranch has donated a two day/three night prairie dog hunt for 4 hunters on the beautiful Circle Ranch which is in the Sierra Diablo Mountains, near Van Horn, Texas. Four additional non hunting guests are welcomed as well. The winners and guests will stay in a nice bunkhouse and need to bring their own vehicles and food. They will enjoy hunting six large prairie dog towns. L120A – 2x1 Manitoba Black Bear. Canadian Sub-Arctic Hunting has donated a 7 day black bear hunt for one hunter for June or September 2010 or 2011.

Located in the northernmost areas of Manitoba, Canada, Canadian Sub-Arctic Hunting is acclaimed for their large number of BIG color- phase bears (cinnamons, chocolates and blondes) plus unbelievable fishing. This is virgin territory and the bear populations are excellent with many bears 300 - 350 lbs. 70% of the bears we take measure 6'6" or bigger with several over 7' each year. This is also one of the few areas in NA where hunters have a chance at large color-phase bears. There is literally 10 hours of daylight and the bears are active at all times of the day. No sitting around waiting all day to hunt, we hunt all hours of the day and fish too. Each camp is on a lake, 7 - 20 miles long, ensuring excellent water access to bait locations and, of course, spectacular fishing. We run two 7 day hunts, each with only 2-3 hunters per week at camp. Stands are tree stands and tripods and can easily accommodate bow hunters. This is a custom-made hunt and your guide/cook/camp manager is experienced and dedicated to your satisfaction. Each camp has a satellite telephone or two-way radio, comfortable wall tents and cots, gravity-feed water system for showering, and generators and freezers for all camps. Your group of 2-3 will have the entire area, a 100 sq. mile minimum, as yours for the week as you hunt in one of the most remote regions of North America. All trips originate from Winnipeg MB. **All meals, accommodations, guide, charter flights from Winnipeg and return, and boat/motor/gas are included.**

Hunt can be upgraded to include moose for \$4,000. Cost of extra hunter is \$4,595 and non-hunters \$2,995. Transportation during the hunt is by boat and plane. Accommodations are tent. Not included are licenses \$300 for black bear and \$35 fishing.
