Educating the Public on Hunting and Wildlife Conservation**

SILENT AUCTION RULES

1. A bid sheet is displayed with each item. Please print legibly and include your **name** and **bid amount** on each respective bid sheet. By placing your name and bid on the bid sheet, you are creating a binding agreement to pay for the item at the close of the silent auction if you are deemed the highest bidder.
2. Bidders may raise the bid as high as desired, as long as the **incremental bid amount** is maintained for each subsequent bid. Thus, your bid must be higher than the previous bid *by no less than* the incremental bid amount as indicated on each respective bid sheet.
3. The silent auction will be closed by respective numbered sections at various intervals throughout the banquet program. Appropriate announcements will be made throughout the banquet program before closing each silent auction section.
4. In the event of a dispute in the silent auction, the SCI Austin Chapter President, Banquet Chairman, or Board Member shall act as the final authority to determine the winner.
5. A bid may be nullified by the SCI Austin Chapter President, Banquet Chairman, or Board Member for the following reasons:
 - a. lack of incremental bid amount in raise
 - b. illegible writing
 - c. addition of a bid after bidding has closed
6. Winning bidders will be posted outside of the ballroom following the closing of the silent auction. An announcement will be made as to when the silent auction cashier will begin accepting payments. Please check the postings and **pay for winning items before the close of the banquet program.**
8. Payment may be made by cash, check, or major credit card. After you have remitted payment, you may retrieve your items from an auction assistant located at the silent auction area. All items must be paid for and collected by the end of the banquet program.
9. **Any hunt, fishing trip, or destination purchased during the Silent Auction may not be transferred, sold, or assigned to another party without the express written permission of SCI Austin Chapter of Safari Club International and that of the outfitter or donor. The SCI Austin Chapter of Safari Club International reserves the absolute right to cancel, revoke, nullify, or void any hunt, fishing trip, or destination purchased if the high bidder transfers, sells, or assigns any hunt, fishing trip, or destination to another party without first obtaining the express written permission of SCI Austin Chapter and that of the outfitter or donor.**

BID-O-GRAM AUCTION RULES

The Bid-O-Gram is a blind bidding method, which allows you to bid on one or more items on one convenient bid sheet. Bid-O-Gram tablets will be located on your table or available from an auction representative. Bidder Name and current bids for all Bid-O-Gram Items will be displayed in the Main Ballroom throughout the evening. By placing your Name and bid on the bid sheet, you are creating a binding agreement to pay for the item at the close of the Bid-O-Gram Auction if you are deemed the highest bidder.

In order to place a bid in the Bid-O-Gram Auction:

1. Print your name in the space provided on the Bid-O-Gram tablet.
2. Place the dollar amount of your bid in the space provided on the Bid-O-Gram tablet next to each respective item.
3. Present your Bid-O-Gram bid to an Auction Representative near your table. The Auction Representative is responsible for delivering your bid to the posting station as expeditiously as possible.
4. Bid as often as you like—if you wish to raise your bid on any item, simply fill out a new form and present the new bid to an Auction Representative.
5. Bids are calculated on a first come, first served basis. The first highest bid delivered to the posting station will supersede all preceding or subsequent lower bids.
6. The Bid-O-Gram Auction will close at the end of the Live Auction. In the event of a tie bid at the close of the Bid-O-Gram Auction, the first bid received at the posting station will be the winning bid.
7. A “Buyer Acknowledgement Form” will be executed by the high bidder of any hunt, fishing trip or destination Bid-O-Gram item at the close of the Bid-O-Gram Auction. When you sign the Buyer Acknowledgement Form, you will do so subject to the terms and conditions of the Official Auction Rules and any disclaimer therein contained.

LIVE AUCTION RULES

When bidding from the floor, raise your hand high and, if necessary, stand to get the attention of the auctioneer or one of his spotters.

The auctioneer and his staff are responsible for the auction. Their rules must be followed explicitly. All decisions of the auctioneer will be final. Auctioneer and staff will decide any disputes regarding the bids during the live auction.

1. We ENCOURAGE you to ask questions ahead of time and speak with the donor if they are present. SCI Austin supports and promotes hunts and trips from donors who are members in good standing with their local and national hunting associations.
2. Some of the items on the donated hunts may not be included unless specified:
 - a. Travel expenses to and from destination
 - b. Hotel and meals before and after the hunt
 - c. Alcoholic beverages
 - d. Trophy dipping, packaging, and shipping
 - e. Gratuities
3. Most hunts, unless otherwise noted are for the 2010 season. Special arrangements other than as set forth on the auction list are expressly between the donor and yourself.
4. A "Buyer Acknowledgement Form" will be executed by the high bidder of any Live Auction item immediately following the auction of each item. When you sign the Buyer Acknowledgment Form, you will do so subject to the terms and conditions of the Official Auction Rules and any disclaimer therein contained.
5. To help expedite the Live Auction process, we ask that payment be made as soon as the item is sold. An Auction Representative will request payment at the same time as executing the Buyer Acknowledgement Form.
6. **Any hunt, fishing trip, or destination purchased during the Live Auction may not be transferred, sold, or assigned to another party without the express written permission of SCI Austin Chapter of Safari Club International and that of the outfitter or donor. SCI Austin Chapter of Safari Club International reserves the absolute right to cancel, revoke, nullify, or void any hunt, fishing trip, or destination purchased if the high bidder transfers, sells, or assigns any hunt, fishing trip, or destination to another party without first obtaining the express written permission of SCI Austin Chapter and that of the outfitter or donor.**

L101 – Banovich’s Jewel of the Crater. “This piece was inspired by a friend for his anniversary. I wanted to portray the pair of zebra as if they are standing before a large gathering ready to exchange vows. The setting is Lake Makat in Ngorongoro crater. This soda lake attracts thousands of flamingos and the fresh water inlets attract herds of wildebeest and zebra making for a very popular drinking area. The kaleidoscope of white and pink flamingos makes for a perfect backdrop for the black and white striped torsos of the zebra. They contrast perfectly with the cerulean-blue sparkling water, making the whole scene appear as if they are the “Jewel of the Crater.” John Banovich..

JOHN BANOVICH is among the world’s most renowned wildlife artists. His original paintings are owned and exhibited by noteworthy organizations and museums across the globe. He serves on the boards of the Society of Animal Artists and the Craighead Environmental Research Institute. His life and work have been featured in countless international publications, including Africa Geographic, Wildlife Art, Big Sky Journal, Western Art & Architecture, the Artist’s Magazine, and many others, as well as on various television programs aired on the Outdoor Channel, Versus and PBS. Through his art and the Banovich Wildscapes Foundation, he has raised millions for conservation and humanitarian causes. At 45 years of age, Banovich continues to explore and evolve as an artist, pursuing a deep-seated desire to preserve wild species around the world and, through his paintings, freeze them forever in time. L104 - Argentina 7 day Water Buffalo hunt for 1 hunter in 2010 or 2011. Hunt with Jorge Noya - Caza Y Safaris Argentina on this 7 day 1x1

Water Buffalo hunt through free chase, no enclosures, at their ranches in Santiago del Estero, without trophy quality restrictions and no surcharges on golden medal trophies. The hunting area of 50,000 hectares (120,000 acres) is located 25 km. from Santiago del Estero city, capital of Santiago del Estero province, a 50 minute flight from Buenos Aires. Join Rhino of **Rhino Outdoor Adventures** on a 3 day rifle or bow hunt in 2010 for 1 hunter and 1 non-hunter on the beautiful, rugged, remote Haecker Safari Ranch. Included are one mature aoudad and two hogs. Other hunters and non-hunters are welcome to join winning bidder at the current price list and exotics such as Axis, Fallow, Blackbuck and Sika will be available and may be harvested at a reduced rate while on this hunt. The Haecker Safari Ranch is nestled in the Texas Hill Country. Tucked away in the Mountains of Real county between the headwaters of the **Nueces and the Frio Rivers** with free flowing natural springs and abundant creeks and wildlife.
